This project will provide improvements for major local dirt road of an east-west reliever road for the recently improved SR-80, increasing connectivity and emergency vehicle access and improving drainage, water storage, and erosion. Substandard dirt roads throughout the Town of Loxahatchee Groves require increased maintenance and funding, in addition to causing inherent safety issues in an agricultural/equestrian area with very limited tax base and resources.

Project will provide improvements for major local dirt road of an east-west reliever road for the recently improved SR-80, increasing connectivity and emergency vehicle access and improving drainage, water storage, and erosion.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Project will provide improvements for major local dirt road of an east-west reliever road for the recently improved SR-80, increasing connectivity and emergency vehicle access and improving drainage, water storage, and erosion. Sub-standard dirt roads in the town require increased maintenance and funding and cause safety issues in an agricultural/equestrian area with very limited tax base and resources.

All citizens within this rural agricultural/equestrian community, that is targeted at 3,200 residents, and the residents within Palm Beach County.
