Goal is to improve life, health & safety for children, residents, visitors with reduced flooding around the library, the City's park and City Hall Complex, safer transportation and reduction of pollutants entering the Caloosahatchee River Basin & Estuary, and protection of wildlife with improved water quality with the design and construction of the proposed drainage improvements. Provides for safe access to the City's park, library and City Hall facilities.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Through the City's procurement policy/procedures, preliminary engineering, surveying, engineering, and construction services will be secured for the proposed drainage and infrastructure improvements at the library, the City's park, and City Hall facilities.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

When constructed, direct services provides safe access to/from and inside the park, library and City Hall facilities, and safer transportation; improved life, health and safety with reduced flooding and with the reduction of pollutants entering the mouth of the Caloosahatchee River Basin and Lake Okeechobee Watershed with the installation and completion of the stormwater treatment components.

Project is included on Page 60 of the January 2020 Caloosahatchee River and Estuary Basin Management Action Plan/Project No. No. F-09. Certification of the project.
