Access to recreation fields will provide the youth and all residents of the Highpoint community recreation opportunities that do not currently exist. Physical activity has been identified as a strategy that improves social and emotional well-being in at-risk youth. Increased recreational opportunities for students at adjacent Highpoint Elementary and local high school lacrosse teams will assist in educational experience and performance. Providing alternative organized team activities for children in this underserved area will decrease the likelyhood of children experimenting with harmful substances. Providing recreational activities during the time children are not in school will offer alternatives to unsupervised activities which may lead to youth crime. Increased student participation and achievement. Track the number of youth drug arrests in this geographical area over time.
