b. Describe the source of funding that can be used in lieu of state funding.



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This funding is entirely State-based. Previously funded forensic residential programs have historically

been entirely State-funded, since they serve clients who are being either stepped down or diverted

from State secure forensic residential facilities. Therefore, it would be extremely difficult to find any

funding source other than state dollars.

10. Has the entity requesting this project received any federal assistance related to the COVID-19 pandemic?

ØApalachee Center: \$887,283 - supplies, cleaning, and testing; as well as additional costs for contract staffing during extreme staffing shortages.

ØLifestream: \$1,808,484 - from Federal government for guaranteeing continuation of inpatient psychiatric services and for contract staffing and other expenses incurred due to COVID-19. ØGracepoint: \$150,365.26 – spent on COVID-19 related equipment utilized in their CSU and \$3,517,700 from Federal Gov for the PPP loan. 100% of that was spent on salaries which has already been submitted for forgiveness and approved.

12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The purpose of this program is to provide a resource for the diversion of seriously mentally ill individuals from less appropriate and/or more expensive venues into the community mental health system.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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Step-down and diversion services for individuals with serious mental illness who are involved in the criminal justice system are desperately needed to maximize State and law enforcement resources in the community and within the State psychiatric system. The purpose of this program is to provide a resource for the diversion of seriously mentally ill individuals from less appropriate and/or more expensive venues into the community mental health system. Apalachee Center, Lifestream and Gracepoint are able to expand their current forensic mental health residential programs with three 16 bed units (48 total beds), located in N Florida, C Florida, & SW Florida. The programs would be for direct diversion services from County jails across the counties of Circuits 2, 3, 5, 7, 8, 9, 10, and 14 and provide step-down services from State secure forensic beds at State Psychiatric Hospitals across Florida. Forensic services within the state psychiatric system cost an average of \$353- daily.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Level 1 Community Residential Facility housing and associated competency restoration, psychiatric, case management, court liaison, discharge planning, group and individual counseling, psychiatric assessment and psychiatric rehabilitation services for individuals diverted from the criminal justice system and stepped down from State secure forensic facilities.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

High-risk seriously mentally ill forensic residential populations

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

This project will divert individuals with serious mental illness from more expensive or less appropriate venues. Forensic hospital services within the state psychiatric hospital system cost an average of \$353- daily, and all are above \$315-daily. The beds provided in this proposal would be priced at \$270- per day, a 24% cost savings. The success of this project will be measured by the percentage of program participants who are able to be safely transitioned to a less restrictive care venue.
