Project completion will result in a multi-use path that will improve physical and mental health as well as improve transportation and economic activity.

Many Destin residents and visitors will use the facility on a daily basis, however no specific population is targeted by this program.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

With this addition of this trail, there will be an increase in bicycle and pedestrian traffic therefore decreasing the traffic on the roads. This corridor will also provide inter-community connectivity between residential areas, commercial zones, and parks. Trail use will be monitored periodically by city staff and public feedback will be requested.

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A consequence for this project not being completed would include the loss of potential jobs related to the construction and the increased viability of the Towncenter Community Redevelopment Act area. The community growth in this area has been a challenge and if this project is denied or postponed it would have a negative impact on the area residents and businesses. Standard contract penalties are sufficient.
