The scope of work consists of finalizing the design plans to up-size existing drainage infrastructure and construct new drainage infrastructure, including ditch bottom inlets, manholes, piping, and ex-filtration, as well as constructing improvements to the existing pond.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The intended purpose of the funds is to perform drainage improvements. The City intends to procure a contractor to design and construct the improvements. Residents will be provided with safe streets and access to there residence during flood instances.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The shovel ready project would benefit the entire City especially an under-served portion of the City; by reducing flooding and the benefits of the water quality. This improvement reduces the severity and duration of flooding in this problem area. This improvement also provides water quality benefit by providing additional exfiltration, which increases stormwater infiltration.

This improvement reduces the severity and duration of flooding in the problem area. This outcome will be measured based on the number of floods at the projected site during rain events.
