14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Citywide stormwater and canal infrastructure restoration and rehabilitation will increase stormwater delivery capacity and reduce canal embankment failure due to erosion and potential settlement. Restoration of stormwater infrastructure, dredging, and earthen embankment rehabilitation and improvements to their resiliency is necessary to protect the community, property and the environment, while preserving drainage basins and the canal systems as intended.



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b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Contractor services include the use of CCTV (i.e. video) inspections, condition reports, pipe lining, point repairs, ROW restoration, installation of stabilizing "geotubes" along deteriorated earthen embankments, dredging of the canals, and/or other applicable methods necessary to preserve drainage basin areas and canal systems.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Reduced flooding events by increasing system conveyance under normal rainfall conditions and to improve system resiliency against sea level rise.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The City of Margate residents and businesses. Approximately 30,000.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Expected to reduce the incidence of flooding by increasing system conveyance under normal rainfall conditions and to improve system resiliency against sea level rise.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The Contractor will be required to obtain a performance and maintenance bond, as may be required by law, and provide a schedule by which they intend on delivering the construction requirements.
