#### 14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

This project will connect the the existing sidewalk system from Maitland Middle and Dommerich Elementary Schools to Deloraine Trail. There is currently not a sidewalk for children to walk to school from the intersection of Mohican Trail and Thistle Lane to the Highland Park Estates and Dommerich Hills Subdivisions. This section of sidewalk is proposed to connect to new sidewalk to be constructed in the Dommerich Hills subdivision as part of the Dommerich Hills Septic to Sewer Project.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The funding would be used for the construction costs to build the sidewalk and intersection improvements.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The completed sidewalk will provide a safe connection from the intersection of Mohican Trail and Thistle Lane to the Highland Park Estates and Dommerich Hills Subdivisions where no sidewalk currently exists and eliminate the need for pedestrians to walk in the roadway, therefore improving transportation conditions.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population for the project is estimated to be for 400-600 homes and approximately 2000 residents.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

After the completion of the project, pedestrians will no longer need to walk in the street to take this route. The outcome will be measured by the before and after observations.
