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14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The funds requested would be utilized for the construction and acquisition of the necessary infrastructure to harden and fortify the Pasco Sheriff's Office Emergency Operations Center located at Florida's Forensic Institute for Research, Security, and Tactics (F1RST) in Land O'Lakes, FL. With this infrastructure, we will take a critical step to maintain operational readiness to better protect the safety of our citizens before, during, and after a disaster or emergency.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

With these funds and the acquisition of the hardening improvements described herein, the Pasco Sheriff's Office will be able to fully harden the Pasco F1RST Campus and ensure that law enforcement can coordinate in the most effective and efficient manner possible for the benefit of the citizens of Pasco County.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

As described above, communities and citizens in Pasco County would be serviced through the benefit of increased efficiency and effectiveness by first responders whenever a disaster may strike. By ensuring that law enforcement has the ability to coordinate from a secure base of operations during an emergency or disaster, we can take critical steps to reinforce our ability to deploy first responders in the most effective and efficient manner.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population served by this project would be the citizenry of Pasco County as a whole. As a result of this funding, the Pasco Sheriff's Office will be able to ensure that our first responders providing emergency response before, during, and after a major emergency or natural disaster will be able to do so in the most efficient and effective manner as possible.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

As a result of the funds requested for this project, the expectation is that Pasco residents will benefit from the ability of the Pasco Sheriff's Office to effectively maintain operation of a centrally located emergency operations center before, during, and after an emergency or disaster, which would result in the fortification of our ability to protect our citizens' safety as well as our ability to assist with cleanup and restoration efforts. These benefits can be measured through increases to coordination and operational readiness as well as decreases to panic and concern about emergency response from Pasco citizens.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Failure to utilize the funds in the method outlined in this request would result in return of funds to the state.
