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Provide residents and visitors to the Neighborhood Lakes Trailhead additional amenities to better serve those who are cycling, running, or walking the 2.3 mile Neighborhood Lakes Scenic Trail and 6.6 Wekiva Regional Trail that the Neighborhood Lakes Trailhead serves in Lake County. Both of these trails connect to additional miles of trail in Orange and Seminole Counties.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Provide amenities such as water and shade for residents and visitors who use the two multi-use trails at the Neighborhood Lakes Trailhead.

Residents and visitors to Lake County who come to bicycle, run, or walk the Wekiva Regional Trail and the Neighborhood Lakes Scenic Trail.
