Reduction of crime in the City of South Miami and surrounding areas and greater accountability with the recording of traffic stops. The in car video systems will compliment the Police Departments Axon body cameras and electronic control devices.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Possible reduction in crime with the apprehension of more felony vehicles and identifying felony vehicles and other violations within residential areas. Reduce citizen complaints and increase accountability with a different view other then the body camera. The in car video system provides 180 degree recording from the dash of the police vehicle as well as recording detention areas within the police vehicle.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Residents of South Miami and surrounding areas. Approximately 20,000 individuals.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Increase in felony and misdemeanor apprehensions, possible reduction in crime and decreased citizen complaints. The comparison of previous years numbers of apprehensions, crime and complaints compared to a full year of use of requested equipment.
