The South Miami Police Department wants to increase community safety and police accountability by incorporating available license plate reader technology in all its patrol vehicles and deployment of traffic trailers. They will purchase and install in-car fleet cameras which incorporate the latest in license plate recognition technology as well as record all traffic stops. In conjunction with the fleet cameras the City will deploy speed measuring trailers with advisory signs within the City with license plate reader technology. The license plate reader will be integrated with the Miami-Dade Police Departments real time crime center to provide county wide alerts of electronically captured felony vehicles. The in car fleet cameras license plate readers will immediately notify officers of felony vehicles within his vicinity. With this technology it is the hope of the SMPD to pro-actively identify and apprehend felony subjects before other crimes are committed.
