#### 14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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This request for \$100,000 will support ZooTampa's manatee field response team by acquiring an 8-passenger transport vehicle to carry ZooTampa staff and volunteers to assist FWC at manatee release sites. Additionally, it will fund the acquisition of a small jon boat and trailer for ZooTampa staff and volunteers to assess distressed manatees reported by the public to help determine need for rescue by FWC and then monitor the manatee until FWC can respond.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

ZooTampa staff and volunteers will support FWC manatee field operations, as requested. Activities will include providing additional manpower to move manatees being released from the truck to the water, as heavy equipment is not available at release sites to lift the animal. Additionally, ZooTampa staff and volunteers will assist FWC by assessing the condition of manatees reported by the public as distressed and monitoring the animal until FWC can respond.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Through this project, ZooTampa will be better equipped to assist FWC in responding to public calls reporting distressed manatees.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population served by this project is Florida residents and tourists who experience manatees in the wild and are served by FWC through its manatee field operations.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

FWC will have additional resources and support to carry out its manatee field operations. ZooTampa will maintain time and activity logs and vehicle use records for these operations to document its service to FWC.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Funds will be returned to the State (FWC) if the project deliverables and performance measures in the contract are not met.
