The project would: 1) protect the water quality of Gemini Springs by eliminating existing septic system in the PFA. 2) increase the alternative water supply benefiting Volusia Blue Spring. These protections are a fulfillment of a 2016 Aquifer Springs Protection Act. Funds will assist in developing a Retrofit Master Plan associated with converting approximately 2000 septic systems to a centralized sewer collection system.

Septic-to-sewer replacement of septic tanks.

Conversion of septic tanks to a wastewater treatment facility from the proposed retrofit area.

Residents and/or businesses located within the designated areas within the 2016 Aquifer Springs Protection Act.

Cleaner water by eliminating septic tanks in proximity to Gemini Springs. The spring will be evaluated using TMDL/BMAP methodology to monitor the spring nutrient loading and long term project benefit installing new central services to reduce impact of existing septic systems.

Volusia County receives state and federal grant assistance and is a good steward of funds and a long track record of meeting deliverables and performance measures within grants offered to the county.
