a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Purpose of project is to make necessary enhancements to create safe play and encourage greater utilization of Francis Park Sports facility: refurbishing the sports fields will create a safer and more welcoming surface for players; dugout improvements will create safe and line of sight for parents facilities; lighting upgrades will provide safer and longer hour usage of facilities; and new scoreboards will offer a more suitable facility for hosting tournaments.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



Activities will include infield and outfield conditioning and refurbishment including turf care, baseline alignment, new bases and pitching mounds. Enhanced lighting with low energy LED light fixtures, dugout modifications to allow for direct line of site of children for parents and coaches. Reconstruction of field 5 to allow for adjustable bases for a multipurpose field.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Francis Athletic Park is utilized by Palatka Babe Ruth for its baseball program which runs enrollment of 300+ youth per season, Peniel Baptist Academy's youth baseball program as well as numerous local travel team organizations. Youth sports and athletics is a proven resource to engage community youth in activities which directly support their physical, emotional and mental health and wellbeing.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

All citizens of Putnam County as well as visitors to the county will be served by this project.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will

be measured?

Project will benefit physical and mental health, cultural experience through community involvement, increased tourism, and reduction of substance abuse. Positive community feedback over improved field quality, increased park use, the hosting of tournaments at the park, and increased youth participation in competitive sports will be the qualitative indicators of the intended benefits of the program being realized.
