The Florida Department of Transportation has a current project for the resurfacing of US Hwy 441 / 301 /SR 500 / SE Abshier Blvd. A portion of this \$15.7 million project runs through the City of Bellevue. Resurfacing and stormwater management construction has started as shown in the photograph below. The City of Bellevue has sewer lines running underneath this highway in multiple locations crossing from one side of the road to the other. Some lines were constructed as early as the 1950s. These 70-year-old lines need inspection, cleaning, repair, and slip lining to maintain integrity and keep the sewer system stable. Destabilization of these lines would result in road closures affecting approximately 30,000 travelers per day that drive through Bellevue
