Used for Public Safety Personnel Costs; Employee leave due to Covid; telecommunications system and commission chamber infrastructure to facilitate remote working, governmental business and public meetings; and PPE. \$5,234,421 in ARPA funding, \$2.69 million of this was allocated toward potable water; the remainder is PPE; Emergency Responder Communication Equipment; broadband; public educational; as well as health and safety programs.

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The construction of approximately 39,823 linear feet of potable water mains and approximately 113 fire hydrants within unincorporated areas.

The unincorporated areas do not currently have fire hydrants on the streets. This project would greatly increase public safety as it would increase fire suppression.

The target population would be those currently residing in and adjacent to the unincorporated areas.

The expected benefit will be fire suppression in the unincorporated areas and the reduced risk of fire spreading from the unincorporated area to the adjacent neighborhoods.
