1. Project Title Hilliard - Sanitary Sewer Collection System Rehabilitation

4. Project/Program Description

The Town of Hilliard's Sanitary Sewer Collection System (SSCS) experiences significant Infiltration & Inflow due to the age of the system. During significant storm events, a substantial amount of storm water enters the existing wastewater collection system through damaged pipe and degraded manholes and must be processed by the Town's Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF). This causes major problems throughout the collection system and the Town's WWTF, including wear and tear on the WWTF and surges in the collections system causing overflows throughout the SSCS and at the WWTF. This uncontrolled discharge of untreated sewage in the community creates a public health and safety risk. The Town of Hilliard is applying for funding to mitigate this Inflow and Infiltration of storm water into its Sanitary Sewer Collection System (SSCS) by rehabilitating and replacing portions of the Town's SSCS.

The Town of Hilliard's Sanitary Sewer System will become more resilient and have the ability to remain fully operational during severe storms, tropical cyclones and significant rain events (flooding conditions),

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The rehabilitation of the town's sanitary sewer collection system will require engineering design, bidding and construction observation services as well as the rehabilitation of 46,500 linear feet of sanitary sewer pipe. The construction of 11 new sanitary sewer manholes, the rehabilitation of 140 existing manholes, the construction of 48 point repairs, the construction of 4,400 LF of new force main, as well as the rehabilitation of one lift station and connected force main.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The Town's sanitary sewer collection system will remain operational during and immediately after significant weather events. Allowing the businesses in the community to remain opened and the residential housing units within the town to remain occupied during and immediately following significant storm events.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Based upon the 2011-2015 American Census Survey the Town of Hilliard contains 3,010 people, 1,955 of which are low and moderate income. All of whom are connected to the Town's central sanitary sewer system. Therefore, all 3,010 people will benefit from the Town's hardened of the sanitary sewer collection system.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will

be measured?

The expected outcome is to harder the Town's sanitary sewer collection system so it can remain fully operational during and immediately following significant storm events. The outcome will be measured by the number of residential and commercial properties whose sanitary sewer collection systems remain fully operational during and immediately following significant weather and natural disaster events.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The Town of Hilliard should have 18 months to carry out this project.
