a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Project includes removal of debris from canal, disposal of material, construction of wall/fencing along the canal to prevent illegal dumping. Area will be cleared of overgrown plants for easier public access to boardwalk. This prevents flooding, reduces storm debris blockages, increases water storage and water quality.



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b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Storm water surges into local businesses and residential areas will be significantly reduced and controlled during rainy season, and during severe weather occurrences such as tropical storms and hurricanes.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Stormwater improvements and pollutant control systems to reduce pollutants discharging from street runoff into waterways, as well as reduce flooding on private properties and City streets and walkways.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

7000+ City residents and visitors.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Improved stormwater management. Comparing the before and after results of access to traffic, decrease street and sidewalk flooding. Physical observation of water being retained in structures or swales for longer periods before running off into adjacent drainage ducts, and observation of less frequent flooding in roadways and walkways.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Failure to meet deliverables without notification of good reasoning will result in financial penalties as described in contract.
