14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The proposed security fencing project will provide much needed security to Altha's ball park and recreation fields. Currently, the park is unsecured and is open for people to sneak into the park and has led to vandalism occurrences and illegal activities. The remaining funding will be to reconstruct the playground area. The current playground is in complete disrepair and is unsafe for children to play on.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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These funds will be used to construct approximately 2,800 LF of 8' security fencing and redesign and constructing the playground area for children to be able to safely enjoy. The playground at the Altha Park is the only playground in the Town besides at the school.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This specific project will bring security and safety to the park to allow citizens to feel safe while also promoting a healthy lifestyle.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This project will serve the entire Town of Altha approximately 500+ population as well as serve all those that visit and play ball at the Town's recreational fields.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

This project will bring a higher level of security and safety to the Altha Park and can be measured through a community survey after one year.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The Auditor General audits for both the Town and State agencies. If the project is not completed within the requirements outlined in the grant award, the funding may be withdrawn.
