The benefit of a secondary pump would allow for the process of pumping fresh gulf water in even at times when the main pump is inoperable. Unfortunately the main pump has had numerous times over the past five years that it has been inoperable for various reasons.

A consequence for this project not being completed would include the degradation of water quality in Destin Harbor in the event of failure of the primary harbor pump. Water quality degradation will result in a negative impact on the fish and wildlife and their habitat in the harbor and surrounding area.
