a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

To recruit, support and develop local entrepreneurs. Grow new business start-ups. Recruit via soft-landing companies from out of the region, state and culinary center. Housing units to address our Housing shortage in the City of Wauchula downtown area. (as evidenced by housing study)

Students, entrepreneurs of all ages, start-up companies, as well as those businesses that are currently under capitalized or in need of and improved business plan to take them to the next level. Hardee county is the best place to live, work and raise a family. In the post COVID era we are observing more and more professionals seeking a rural lifestyle. Hardee County has ubiquitous broadband coverage making it more attractive. This incubator will add value to our community and will bring high wage jobs focused on health care, hospitality and culinary. These industries will add value to the growing economy of the region. The state of Florida and municipal governments will benefit from the enhanced tax base, revitalization and creation of downtown city centers where people live, work and play. ROI will be measured through econometric models (REMI) based on actual jobs created, business investment, and capital expenditures per company recruited and services.
