### 14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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Goal is to address the needs of the community with improvements to Farr Field Park that include baseball fields, dugouts, fencing, entryway improvements, safety drop-off area, ADA compliance, appropriate parking, picnic area, covered pavilion, splash pad, playground, family tent area, covered bleacher seating and landscaping.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Contractual engineering project management, administration and construction services to improve new baseball fields, dug-outs, fencing, entryway improvements, safety drop-off area, ADA and appropriate parking, picnic area, pergola, covered pavilion, splash pad, playground, family tent area, covered bleacher seating and landscaping.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Direct services include improving the quality-of-life & physical well-being, overall health of the community. Parks provide the potential for economic development, property values increases & enhance community cohesion. Farr Field Park is a dynamic community focal point. Improvements will provide the community & youth avenues to participate in organized sports, socialize with family and friends.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Target population is the citizenry of the City of Wauchula that is a Financially Disadvantaged Municipality (ch. 62-552, F.A.C.), located in Hardee County, which is designated as a Rural Area of Economic Concern/Rural Area of Opportunity (s. 288.0656, Florida Statutes) and surrounding communities including sports organizations, tourists, youth, visitors, retirees and residents throughout the State of Florida. Target population includes citizenry, residents, visitors, general public, the business community. Population expected to be served exceeds 25,000.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Expected benefit is meeting the community's need with improved recreational amenities which improves health, quality of life, and wealth of the community. Farr Field Park is the largest recreational park and is a dynamic focal point for the community. The completed improvements also provides for a way to promote economic development, attract visitors, increase tourism, which brings in additional revenues, enhance property values, increase of home buyers, workers, and environmental savings with reductions in managing stormwater costs. Measurement is certification of the project, community feedback, and tracking of usage.

Non payment of invoices until milestones are achieved; implementation of a corrective action plan.
