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a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The main purpose is to relieve some of the wear and tear on one bathroom and make a more fluid time of bathing

children and adults in timely manner. Prior to our purchasing the house, the owner had added a room that actually
covered the existing septic. The septic for that side of the house has been an issue. The bathroom overflows at times and
the toilet stops up regularly. The plumbing needs to be replaced. Presently in the large room, we have movable partitions
with lack of privacy for our clients and children go in there at times taking things from others. We would like to be able to
give the clients more security for their things. The water is tested regularly and needs the osmosis system for drinkable
water.

Quicker bathing times and better usage for the toilet.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

A secure and safe place to keep their clothing and personal items. We offer direct services including feeding, housing, daily living skills, parenting, DV survivor, inner healing, addictions program, anger management, vocational skills training, educational referrals, vocational referrals, etc. We then help the clients to find a more permanent housing.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Homeless and domestic violence survivors and their children. (Women and children up to 21 clients per day.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The benefit will be the clients to have a more secure and private area (bedrooms) to stay, easily accessible and working bathrooms, and good drinking water.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

If funds are not used as indicated, or if shelter renovations are not made as per contract, the shelter should repay the funding and would jeopardize further grants from the state.
