a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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Goal is to ensure safety of first responders, citizenry, protection of life, health and property with replacement of old portable/ mobile emergency radios, dispatch consoles, equipment/software for use by multiple agencies: Okeechobee County EMS, Fire Rescue, Sheriff, School Board, Utility Authority & BOCC with SLERS-2 APCO P-25 Phase 2 system. Meets DMS Law Enforcement Communications Plan: direct communications with all state law enforcement agencies, 24/7/365.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Activities include purchase, install, test and train staff on SLERS-2 APCO Standards P-25 Phase 2 compliant portable/mobile radios, dispatch consoles, software/hardware that will be used by multiple county agencies for greater interoperability for all users in emergencies, hurricanes, hazardous events, daily operations of public safety.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Direct services to citizens in this Rural Area of Critical Economic Concern and Rural Area of Opportunity is statewide communications on the SLERS-S APCO Standards P-25 radio system that provides greater interoperability for all users, improved response to safe lives, reduce fatalities/injuries property damage, etc. Maintains a safe, healthy, quality of life. Provides safety professionals the required equipment to respond to emergencies, accidents, weather related events to serve the citizens efficiently and effectively.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Population served is the residents, businesses and visitors of Okeechobee County, which is designated as a Rural Area of Critical Economic Concern per Executive Order #11-81; and as outlined in s. 288.0656, F.S., Rural Economic Development Initiative (REDI) as a Rural Area of Opportunity; Greater than 40,000 expected to be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Measure is installed and operational SLERS-2 APCO P-25 Phase 2 radio systems for use by multiple county agencies; Meets DMS Law Enforcement Communications Plan, 2018 Edition; interoperability is key to protecting the general public from harm; cost efficient and effective; and completion and certification of the project.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Contractual milestones to be adhered to throughout the project; non-payment of invoices until milestones addressed; and liquidated damages, if needed.
