14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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The specific goal or purpose would be to continue delivering the six core programs at ASCF and to increase services to more youth and families in foster care through outpatient services. Another goal would be to engage other service providers to continue to build trauma informed systems and processes to better serve this population of children and families. Through consultation, collaboration, and partnership, ASCF aims to increase better outcomes and decrease negative outcomes for children and families with foster care involvement.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The funds will be used to continue to implement our six core programs: Evidence Based Trauma Interventions, Trauma Trainings, Foster Parent Support, Trauma Informed Systems Integration, Birth Family Engagement, and Enrichment Services. With a sustained focus on implementing and refining these programs on our campus we are increasing capacity to serve more children and families in the community through outpatient services.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Direct services include evidence-based clinical therapy, development therapies, psychological assessment, multidisciplinary teaming and coordination of care including consultation with child welfare case managers, teachers, and other system providers. Birth family engagement includes child-parent interactions and interactions between ASCF foster parents and birth families.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population are children in foster care in the 12th judicial circuit, foster parents, birth families, and other system providers who we work collaboratively with to coordinate care. We aim to serve 200-300 individuals during this funding cycle.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

We aim to increase positive outcomes and decrease negative outcomes for children in foster care. These outcomes are measured through a battery of assessments given periodically throughout treatment. These assessments may include child behavior checklists, trauma symptom checklist for youth, and regular reporting through our electronic health records. Method of measurements would be that once we engage clients in evidence-based treatment modalities, our hope would be that their trauma symptomatology would decrease throughout their participation in services. We contract and collaborate with a primary care physician and other services including occupational and speech therapy as well as implementing neuro-psychological evaluations. Increased accessibility for specialized services is measured through participation in services. Typical providers have long wait lists so linkage to these services help increase their accessibility to these services.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Suggested penalties to be considered would be to put corrective action plans together to ensure deliverables and performance measures as well as to discontinue funding after a certain period for failing to meet outcome measurements and deliverables.
