The shell midden at Historic Spanish Point is comprised of 5,000 years of Florida history and is one of the few fully intact shell middens remaining in Sarasota County. Its bayfront location and the impact of storms has compromised this critical archaeological site making it at risk for damage from future hurricanes. It will take several years to complete the project due to permitting requirements. The initial amount requested will allow us to begin the planning process.
