14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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The funding will assist with costs to eliminate approximately 373 septic tanks. The scope of the Christobel Septic Tank Phase-Out project includes a new wastewater collection system and a pump station to deliver collected wastewater to an off site point of connection to the JEA system.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The funding will assist with costs to eliminate approximately 373 septic tanks. The scope of the Christobel Septic Tank Phase-Out project includes a new wastewater collection system and a pump station to deliver collected wastewater to an off site point of connection to the JEA system.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The elimination of septic tanks will be a benefit to the homeowners, an improvement to the neighborhood, and would benefit the adjacent impaired water body by eliminating nutrient loading from drain fields. Approximately 73% of the homeowners in the Beverly Hills Subdivision have executed Temporary Construction Easements in support of the program.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The Christobel subdivision is in the Northwest quadrant of Jacksonville and is near Moncrief Creek, an impaired water body.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

In 2016 the City of Jacksonville and JEA entered into an Interagency Agreement to phase-out septic tanks. Areas of high priority consist of failing tanks, proximity to impaired water bodies and the elimination of future proliferation of septic tanks. Christobel is ranked amongst the top five areas in Jacksonville for phasing out septic tanks. The elimination of septic tanks will be a benefit to the homeowners, an improvement to the neighborhood, and would benefit the adjacent impaired water body by eliminating nutrient loading from drain fields.
