The Town of Cross City will immediately place the new fire engine in service. This will be accompanied by formal training on the new equipment for the Firefighters/First Responders.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Improved reliability for the Town of Cross City's Fire-Rescue Service. It will also enhance and upgrade the City's firefighting capability, utilizing the latest equipment technology.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

It will serve 100% of the Town of Cross City population of 2591. Will also provide mutual aid to Dixie County with a population of 16,759.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Immensely improve the Cross City Fire Department's ability to respond for life safety and property protection. Additionally, the Town of Cross City is located along State Road 55/U.S. Hwy 19/Alt 98, which is a major thoroughfare and designated evacuation route, thus allowing this equipment to be of potential service to countless citizens, visitors, and passersby.

The Town of Cross City will need to ensure an on-time delivery of the equipment prior to finalizing the purchase. This can be realized by researching the vendor's most recent history of product availability and delivery.
