This funding will support more efficient and cost effective operations aimed at reducing the average annual expenditure of \$26 million in electricity.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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This will be achieved through upgrading and expanding electrical metering and data analytics at wastewater facilities through the installation of electrical, flow, and pressure meters combined with an analytics tool to monitor and inform the optimization of energy use intensity at the wastewater process level.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Energy is required to treat and dispose of wastewater at the three wastewater treatment plants serving Miam-Dade County.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The wastewater treatment plants serve more than 2.3 Million residents.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

This project will improve Energy Efficiency in the delivery of wastewater services, reduce energy costs and emissions associated with wastewater treatment.

The department will track energy consumed per gallon of wastewater treated, the cost of electricity for wastewater treatment, and estimate Greenhouse gas and pollution emissions reductions.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures is the risk of not recovering reimbursement cost and potential delay in project progress.
