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14. Program Performance

c. Organization Type

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The recently built Broward County Sheriff's Office Real Time Crime Center (RTCC) provides command and control oversight of in-progress events by accessing hardware, such as cameras. By evolving the RTCC into an Intelligence Center, our goal is to prevent an act of targeted mass violence by developing and building an information and intelligence network that collects information from multiple sources, integrates, evaluates and analyzes that information and disseminates or acts upon it.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The vendor will provide servers and software that will integrate multiple data sources, both from within BSO and outside agencies, and integrate them into one common operating platform in which they can all be viewed simultaneously on one mapping software. Law enforcement will be able to collaborate and use this system to identify and act upon imminent threats, patterns of behavior and crime trends. Thereby improving public safety.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The project will allow us to more quickly and efficiently identify criminals and other persons with nefarious intent who are planning to commit, are committing, or have committed a crime within Broward County and throughout the state of Florida, and prevent it from happening or stop it immediately. This will reduce crime, reduce response times to calls for service, and increase arrests and incarceration rates due to the digital evidence and infrastructure being built out.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The residents and visitors of Broward County, along with all Floridians, will benefit from the establishment of a BSO Regional Intelligence Center that will improve the effectiveness and efficiency of law enforcement response and intervention throughout the state by communicating directly and sharing information and intelligence with our municipal law enforcement partners, other regional Fusion Centers and local RTCCs. Approximately 2-18 million residents.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected success factors of the Regional Intelligence Center will be the amount of shared intelligence information throughout the state which emanated from Broward County, the reduction of crime within Broward County and statewide, lowered response times, identification of persons of interest, etc. It will be measured through state and local crime rates and other statistical measures.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Performance bonds will be negotiated into the service contract with strict dates of delivery and deliverable items.
