a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The funding request by the Florida Goodwill Association (FGA) will create direct jobs, training, and placement services that will result in expanded employment opportunities for persons with barriers to employment such as low-income individuals, the disabled, and veterans. DEO contracts with and administers the program to determine the required number of full-time positions/jobs when combined with a required FGA funding match of 4 to 1.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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Direct jobs, employment services such as training and placement to low-income individuals, and individuals with barriers to employment.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The Florida Goodwill Association (FGA) is comprised of nine autonomous Goodwill Agencies, each serving the people of a multi-county region. The FGA advocates for services to meet the needs of people with barriers to employment while concurrently strengthening families and communities. FGA strives to enhance the dignity and quality of life of individuals by helping people reach their full potential.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

While anyone is eligible for the job training services provided by the nine Florida-based Goodwills, the following individuals are the primary population being served:

- Jobless persons
- Economically disadvantaged persons
- At-risk Youth
- Homeless
- Current and former incarcerated persons
- e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Goodwills across the state collect information to create an economic and fiscal impact study done by the independent firm, Elliott D. Pollack and Company. This study analyzes the local, state, and regional implications of all nine Florida Goodwill Association (FGA) members in terms of three basic measures: impact of job placements, impact of operations, and the impact of capital improvements.
