There is a demonstrated need for expanded utility infrastructure along the new CR 280B Connector Road. By expanding facilities along the roadway, the City of DeFuniak Springs would see new commercial and residential development and new mixed use, residential and industries.

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The funding will allow for engineering, permitting, construction and inspection to upgrade components within the existing water and wastewater systems. This would allow for increased economic development along with new commercial and residential development.

There will be an increase in area average wages and services such as food, lodging and retail facilities. There will also be an increase in the number of new skilled jobs in the area.
