a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal is to construct a Cultural Facilities Development that will enhance the quality of life for residents and visitors, who may not have access to such a facility and the programming. This will be a state-of-the-art cultural facility equipped with ADA restrooms, kitchen, classrooms, etc.



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b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

This activity involves the development of a cultural facility at the City of West Park. The development will include the construction of a mini-amphitheater. The multipurpose facility will accommodate cultural events and programming day-to-day recreation events. The facility will be entirely ADA accessible to address special needs programming. Once constructed, the facility will be opened for cultural programming to the general public (residents and visitors).

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Once constructed, both residents and visitors will have direct access to a world-class, state of the arts cultural facility. This Cultural Facility Development will allow for direct services in the form of a multipurpose facility. The facility will allow for live performances, culinary showcasing, competition, and recreational events. In addition, the facility may also help spur tourism.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population served will be the residents of the City of West Park. Regardless of age, gender, race, income level, or any other demographics; residents and visitors will be the target population.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit or outcome for this project will be construction of a state of the art, world-class cultural facility. The facility will provide access to residents and visitors who would not normally have access to such cultural programming events within the immediate community.
