The City of Lighthouse Point is requesting funds for a stormwater improvement project on NE 21st Avenue. The funds being requested will provide stormwater and drainage improvements, new sidewalks, ADA improvements, roadway milling and resurfacing, and a multi-use path on NE 21st Avenue from Sample Road to NE 30th Street. This is a highly traveled motorist and pedestrian corridor connecting to local shopping, dining, local government offices, and a Federal facility (USPS).

Flooding and stormwater runoff is a well know issue in the area of NE 21st Avenue from Sample Road to NE 30th Street. The project will mitigate environmental hazards associated with stormwater runoff and improve local surfacewater quality. The project will remove flood waters from roadways. and reduce flood stages and durations. It will also improve pedestrian safety with the installation of ADA sidewalks and shared use bike lanes. improvements will benefit pedestrian mobility and safety, enhance handicapped persons mobility, and bicycle travel and safety.

**c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?**

Flooding from rainfall will be mitigated, which will protect persons and property in the residential area. The method for measuring this benefit will be through site assessment and observation including feedback from the community and accident statistics provided by the Police Department.
