### 14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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This project will provide funding for planning and preliminary design work to develop a septic to sewer treatment and collection system in the unincorporated area of Sumter County consisting of the Lake Panasoffkee water service area. The development of a septic to sewer treatment and collection system will stop existing leaching of waste from septic systems into Lake Panasoffkee. Further, FDEP has spent approximately \$6 million dollars dredging sludge from Lake Panasoffkee caused by the septic tanks that will be replaced by this project. This project will prevent further expenditures

on sludge dredging.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Wastewater treatment and collection will be provided to 1295 households in Sumter County and waste will no longer leach into Lake Panasoffkee.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Wastewater treatment and collection services will replace septic systems to 1295 households in Sumter County.

Low income residential properties properties in the unincorporated area of Sumter County consisting of the Lake Panasoffkee water service area will be provided wastewater treatment and collection. 1295 households will be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The replacement of septic systems with a wastewater treatment and collection system will improve the health and welfare of 1295 households the unincorporated area of Sumter County consisting of the Lake Panasoffkee water service area. The replacement of the septic systems will stops leaching of waste from the septic systems into Lake Panasoffkee and the water table. The outcome will be measured by routine monitoring and testing of water quality in the area by FDEP and the county health department.
