	Expand utilities (potable water & sewer) to two communities within Estero there were impacted by Hurricane Ian storm surge. Estero River Heights and Cranbrook Harbor currently use groundwater wells and septic tanks. A study prepared by Florida Gulf Coast University indicates septic tanks are a source of nutrients and bacteria to the Estero River and Estero Bay. Due to over pumping, single family drinking water wells are becoming a less reliable source of water due to reduced water volumes and decreased quality. This project will have a regional impact by improving water quality in the Estero Rive and Estero Bay. This will improve public safety, recreation, and fishing in the area. The project will also benefit The Koreshan State Park, Mound Key Archaeological State Park, and Estero Bay Aquatic Preserve which are all located along the Estero River and Estero Bay.

#### 14. Program Performance

a. Organization

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The purpose of the funds request is to improve the quality of water in the Estero River, Estero Bay and Estero Bay Aquatic Preserve. The Estero Bay has been identified as impaired for nutrients and the Estero River has been identified as impaired for bacteria. Septic Tanks have been identified as sources of both within the watershed. Removing septic tanks will reduce the nutrient and bacteria load to the River and Bay helping to improve water quality and reduce the impairments.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The project will remove septic tanks from Estero River Heights and Cranbrook Harbor that drain to the Estero River/Estero Bay. Removing the septic tanks and sending the wastewater to a wastewater treatment plant will eliminate a source of nutrient and bacteria pollution to the Estero River/Estero Bay.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Citizens will see improved water quality in the Estero River and Estero Bay. Citizens in the project area will be provided central potable water and sewer which are safer and more reliable sources.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population service by this project are the with Estero River Heights and Cranbrook Harbor. Both communities were heavily impacts by Hurricane Ian. Approximately 197 properties within Estero are expected to be provided water and/or sewer service via this project.

The improved water quality in the Estero River and Estero Bay will serve all residents in Estero, City of Bonita Springs, Town of Fort Myers Beach and Lee County.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit from the project is improve quality of water in the Estero River and Estero Bay and improve reliability of water and wastewater services to residents.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The project construction bid documents will require a bond to cover the bid amount to ensure the contractor completes the project. The Village proposes to include liquidated damages in the project's construction contract.
