4. Project/Program Description

Project Gadsden Wellness - Our Future's target population will be senior citizens, individuals that are considered homeless, and individuals with mental and/or physical disabilities. Gadsden County's population is comprised of 18 to 20 percent of senior citizens, the homeless population in Gadsden County is approximately 6 to 8 percent, and 5 to 7 percent of the population are individuals with mental and/or physical disabilities.

One of the biggest challenges that the senior citizens encounter is inadequate housing. The citizens within the targeted populations struggle with having adequate housing because of a lack of clear titles and/or deeds, insufficient funding for repairs and renovations, and the inability to submit completed applications and other required documents (home insurance, clear deeds, land survey, etc.). The program aims to combat these problems by providing qualified citizens with assistance and stipends to overcome these obstacles.

Health: decrease Diabetes and other health issues due to malnutrition; provide citizens with quality healthcare options to maintain their physical and mental health

Food: provide homeless individuals with a quality meal

Housing: reduce housing issues due to substandard conditions; help individuals increase their property value Job readiness: equipping citizens with the tools to be contributing members of the Gadsden County workforce Methodology:

Health: periodically assess health conditions of each client; count the number of individuals that have been signed up for healthcare and ensuring they are attending appointments

Food: the number of returning and new individuals that are being fed daily

Housing: the number of citizens that can qualify for state and federal programs; the number of individuals that receive assistance to have home renovations; the number of citizens that are helped with retrieving the appropriate housing documentation
