#### 14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The primary objective of the project is to install centralized sanitary lines and send flows to the wastewater treatment plant instead of having homes install septic tanks.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Funds will cover the installation of 6,000 linear feet of 18 inch force main that will connect to lift station 127. This will allow the City to connect approximately 4,000 new homes to centralized sanitary sewer system.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?



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New homes would be able to connect to the centralized sanitary sewer. By connecting new homes to the sanitary sewer this would prevent them from having septic tanks that can impair the Rainbow Springs spring shed. Thus preventing total nitrogen that is produced due to On-site Sewage Treatment Disposal Systems (OSTDS) from impacting the Upper Floridan Aquifer.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Roughly 4,000 homes in the Winding Oaks and Heath Brook developments and homes located around lift station 127 area.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

By connecting approximately 4,000 new homes, this prevents them from installing septic tanks. This prevents approximately 57,360 lbs of TN from ever contaminating the groundwater annually. Based on data that the loadings in pounds of nitrogen per OSTDS in Rainbow Springs spring sheds is approximately 9.92 lb-N/person, and the household average in Marion County is 2.41 persons.

Standard penalties, bonding requirements, and state/federal license requirements.
