#### 14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

These dollars are non-recurring capital expenditures for the purpose of purchasing 225 acres in Wakulla County that will lead to the protection of the Chips Hole Cave System. This land acquisition will lead to the protection of Wakulla Springs by relocating a proposed fuel station from development over the Chips Hole Cave System. Once acquired the property will be managed as a wildlands preserve for the benefit of the public and for natural resource protection.



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b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Conservation Florida Inc. has worked with the landowners involved, mulitple community members and organzitions, as well as Wakulla County to plan this real estate transaction. Conservation Florida Inc, will provide it real estate expertise in the acquisition process including collecting and evaluating all due diligence items and assessments and guiding the project through the closing process. Upon successful acquisition Conservation Florida Inc. will work to establish the site as a preserve in partnerhsip with Wakulla County for the benfit of the public and for natural resource based limited recreation.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The protection of surface and groundwater through the perpetual protection of the Chips Hole property. In addition public access and limited recreation will benefit the citizens of Wakulla County and the surrounding region.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The project will protect 225 acres of property that will protect water resoruces in Wakulla County and protect the Wakulla Springs system. The citizens of Wakulla County, 30,000 plus, will benefit from these protections.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Perpetual protection of this property will prevent development that would negatively impact the Chips Hole Cave system and thus Wakulla Springs. Protection of Chips Hole as well as the underground cave system that runs under this property is the best method for water resource protection.
