The building will be tall enough to accommodate Public Works' heavy equipment including Hurricane Debris removal equipment and vehicles, with overhead doors sufficient for ventilated vehicle access and storage. Engineering and design have been completed and the City anticipates starting the construction bid process in early 2025 with construction completion towards the end of 2025.
