These funds will support the design and early development milestones of constructing a dynamic, multipurpose facility for the Education Foundation of Sarasota County that will 1) serve as its new HQ, 2) house direct educational resources, services, and programming for students, teachers, families/caregivers, and community partners, furthering the goals of FDOE, and 3) add 5-floors of multifamily workforce housing or ~80 units for teachers and educational staff to Sarasota's portfolio.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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Funds will be used to complete architectural drawings and begin construction on a 10-story building of workforce housing for educational staff that will be anchored by a centralized HUB to provide direct educational resources, services, and programming for students, teachers, families/caregivers, and community partners, furthering the State's educational and workforce development goals.
