13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Separating vehicular traffic on Spanish River Boulevard from users of the El Rio Trail will improve travel reliability for drivers and improves safety on the City's streets.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Spanish River Boulevard and the El Rio Trail are travel assets for residents and stakeholders in the City of Boca Raton. Improving travel reliability and reducing conflicts and delays are critical to maximizing the connectivity of both facilities, with particular attention to accommodating demand between I-95 and Downtown Boca Raton.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?



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A grade separation of the El Rio Trail will reduce conflicts between drivers on Spanish River Boulevard and trail users on the El Rio Trail. The new facility will be designed for compliance with ADA, ensuring accessibility for all. FAU students and faculty will benefit from improved direct access to the Tri-Rail Station.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Spanish River Boulevard serves over 25,000 vehicles per day in the project area. The El Rio Trail serves an average of 376 users per day.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

A grade separation will improve travel reliability on Spanish River Boulevard by separating vehicular traffic from trail users, reduce potential for crashes with bicyclists and pedestrians, and will increase trail use and ridership at the nearby Tri-Rail Station. The City utilizes a variety of data resources to monitor traffic operations, travel activity and safety, including big data sources and Signal4.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?

No additional penalties should be required, because the City will commit the resources necessary to ensure successful project completion. State funds would not be leveraged until the project is fully funded for construction.
