Those campuses with the most critical needs serve the educational needs of 87% of the students in Levy County. Two of those campuses serve as shelters for the citizens of Levy County. These shelters have also been used to house National Guard troops that have worked in Levy as well as neighboring counties during hurricane cleanup.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Ultimately, the target population is the 42,000 residents of Levy County, which includes students and those most in need during mandatory evacuation conditions.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit is to provide both our students and citizens with a safe and secure area to learn and shelter from any storm that impacts Levy County. This outcome will be measured by our ability to continue to open and operate shelters as needed for our community.
