b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

These funds will contribute directly to the construction activities of the BEG, which when complete, will provide citizens with new access to two National Parks, as well as an alternative mode of transportation and opportunities for physical activity and outdoor recreation.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The BEG will provide citizens with facilities for active transportation, outdoor recreation, physical activity, and connection to other area trails. This project will be the first non-motorized trail in the country to connect two National Parks and would have an immediate economic impact to Homestead and other communities in southern Miami-Dade County.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The project is targeted to serve the 2.8 million residents of Miami-Dade County as a form of non-motorized transportation in a rapidly-growing area of the County that lacks facilities. This includes elderly persons, persons with poor mental or physical health, jobless persons, economically disadvantaged persons, at-risk youth, developmentally or physically disabled persons, preschool students, grade school students, high school students, as well as university and college students.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Project benefits include physical and mental health improvements, quality of life enrichment, cultural experience enrichment, environmental enhancement/preservation/improvements, improved bike and pedestrian safety, safe route to schools, transportation conditions improvement, economic activity improvements, increased tourism, immediate job opportunities, and individuals' economic self sufficiency enhancements. Methodology for measures include health impact assessments, event attendance and greenway usage counts, heat index and tree canopy calculations, numbers of bike and pedestrian injuries and deaths, traffic impact studies, trail user surveys and economic impact studies, sales revenues and sales tax generated within 1/2 mile of the trail corridor, and number of jobs created by the project.
