13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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Goals are to provide a benefit to public health with the installation of a public sewer system; eliminating risk associated with flood events, in which raw sewage from septic systems flows into homes, public right of ways, estuaries and ground water. Improve cost of living for socio-economically disadvantaged population, as septic systems are cost prohibitive. The project will improve health, increase quality of life and reduce impact on Florida wildlife and waterways.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Construction of sanitary sewer force mains, lift stations, gravity mains and sanitary laterals. Construction of new potable water lines to increase pressure and volume.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Citizens will be provided with a public sanitary sewer service that will divert flows from private septic treatment systems to a public wastewater treatment facility. Citizens will also be provided with a new potable water main in order to better facilitate the demands on the water distribution system.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The population directly targeted would the approximately 185 residents of the Town and Country sub-division. This area is predominately occupied by socio-economically disadvantaged residents, who cannot afford the regular maintenance of a private septic system.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

To provide a public sewer system and reduce exposure to wastewater related diseases, improve habitats for local wildlife in surrounding wetlands and beaches by reducing sewage overflows from private septic systems, reduce cost of living by eliminating the expense of citizens operating and maintaining a private septic system.~ and increase the value of the homes in the area.
