13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The specific purpose of this funding request is to empower educators (public, charter, private, microschools and homeschool educators) with training in evidence-based strategies in the science of reading to improve reading proficiencies, provide evidence-based math strategies to increase math proficiencies and science strategies, and using interactive strategies to enhance learning. Training will take place in locations in classroom learning labs on the east and west side of Pasco County.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The program will offer workshops, training and strategy sessions and leadership seminars focused on instructional strategies (science of reading), school improvement and leadership development for public, charter, private, microschools, and homeschool educators. Services include coaching, mentorship and collaborative learning communities to foster peer networking and best practices.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Public, charter, private, microschool and homeschool educators will receive leadership training, coaching and mentorship which will in turn directly benefit students by higher quality and more effective teaching which will drive academic success. The support provided to struggling and low performing schools' teachers and teachers of special needs students will be particularly impactful.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

We anticipate that hundreds of students will be positively impacted when educators receive the training funded by this project. Additionally, communities will be served when academic achievement improves in their local schools.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Analyzing standardized test scores, attendance, discipline rates pre- and post-training surveys, data from classroom observations and evaluations of instructional strategies and practices, teacher growth and retention rates over time. Assisting leadership competencies through self-assessments, surveys, parent surveys and staff retention rates
