The funds will be used to help the construction costs of a fully affordable, 78-unit apartment building. It will be built in Tarpon Springs, on ALT-19 in north Pinellas County -- an area that has traditionally been under-served with new workforce housing construction.

Pinellas County Housing Authority will manage and operate this apartment building which will provide permanent affordable and workforce housing for 78 families and other on-site training programs such as medical health screening services, continuing education for permanent home ownership, and other personal development training.
