13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The Florida Endangered Species Annex will support the breeding and rehabilitation of the Striped Newt and Easterm Indigo Snake, in order to increase the wild populations of these two native species. The Annex will also serve as an education center for the more 1.2 million annual visitors to ZooTampa. In addition, the Annex will house other native species of amphibians and reptiles.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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In addition to the endangered species breeding work done at the Annex, visitors will be able to view other native species of amphibians and reptiles.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

More than 1.2 million visitors per year will be able to see the Florida Endangered Species Annex and learn the importance of species conservation. ZooTampa's work is helping to preserve the endangered amphibian and reptile populations for the benefit of the environment and for the enjoyment of future generations of Floridians

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target populations served by this project are the residents of and visitors to the Tampa Bay region. More than 1.2 million residents and visitors are expected to be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Conservation of two Florida endangered species, the Striped Newt and Indigo Snake, through a breeding program. This will preserve the population of these two species and ZooTampa will track and report all numbers.
