a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Attain and maintain adequate stormwater system and infrastructure resiliency and functionality.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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Citywide stormwater infrastructure and canal embankment rehabilitation will increase stormwater delivery capacity and reduce the development of depressions and cracks on other right of way improvements (i.e. asphalt surfaces, swales, curb/gutters, and sidewalks) due to subsurface settlement. Restoration of stormwater infrastructure improvements for resiliency is necessary in order to continue protecting the community, property and the environment, while preserving drainage basins and mitigating flood risks.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Services include conditions assessments and/or infrastructure repairs and rehabilitation. Services will include the use of CCTV inspections, submissions of condition reports, pipe lining, pipe replacement, and replacement of portions of roadway asphalt, curbs and gutters, sidewalks as well as canal embankment restoration in order to continue protecting the community and preserving drainage basins and the canal systems, as necessary.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

City of Margate with a population of approximately 60,000 as well as benefits the surrounding region.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Protection of the ecosystem which thrives within and around the canal system. A reduction in incidence of flooding under normal rainfall conditions. Improve system resiliency against sea level rise. Benefits can be measured by comparing improvements before and after as well as measured incidence of flood damage.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?

Restoration of stormwater infrastructure improvements to resiliency is necessary in order to continue protecting the community, property and the environment, while preserving drainage basins, addressing vulnerabilities, as well as mitigating and reducing flood risks.
